Theme

Your design should inspire students to use alternative transportation (walking, biking, transit, or carpooling) while promoting safety, community, and sustainability. Keep it modern, fun, and high school-friendly!



- Target Audience: High school students (ages 14-18) – think bold, energetic, and cool designs.
- Design Elements: Include at least one mode of alternative transportation, and emphasize safety or environmental benefits. Use bright, eye-catching colors.
- Size & Format: Designs should be around 4 inches, and can be square, round, or rectangular. Submit your design in .png, .jpg, or .ai format.
- Original Work: The design must be your own.
 No copyrighted images or logos.
