

MENU OF SERVICES

Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School (SRTS) offers technical assistance and support for local active transportation programs and activities in high schools across Oregon. Students, school staff, and SRTS coordinators, and parent volunteers are welcome to apply for services. To request any of these services, **scan the QR code below**. **Services include:**

Organize a Bike Bus



The ODOT SRTS Team can help you organize a bike to school group (also known as a Bike Bus). You'll get to work with Sam Balto from Bike Bus World to help get started, and then the ODOT team will help you plan your route, advertise your group, and kick it off.

Hold a Walk Audit



Walk Audits are tools for understanding the current conditions and challenges for getting around on the streets and sidewalks in a given area. The ODOT SRTS can facilitate a walk audit at your school to help draw attention to school staff, students, or the wider community about where the opportunities are. Walk Audits can be great first steps to initiate a larger conversation about transportation planning.

Volunteer at Elementary Schools



Interested in helping out at a local elementary school? The ODOT SRTS team can help get you connected with a nearby Walking School Bus, Bike Bus, or Bike Education program at an elementary school in your area. This is a great option to gain some volunteer hours and provide mentorship to younger students in your community.

Host a Schoolwide Event



The ODOT SRTS team can help customize an event that is just right for you! Events may include a social bike ride, a walk to school day event, a schoolwide competition or pledge, and more. The ODOT SRTS Team is prepared to walk you through what it takes to plan an event, get the supplies you need, and get the turnout you want to change your community.
